AML Donates More Than \$275k To Hurricane Relief Efforts And The Amount Continues To Climb.....

Nassau, Bahamas, September 13th 2019: AML Foods Limited announced that to date they have donated more than \$275k to Hurricane Dorian Relief. \$200k has been donated to support their employees in Grand Bahama and \$25k was donated to both The Bahamas Red Cross and NEMA. Additionally, through partnerships with international vendors, more than \$30k in product donations have come in. Through the Red Cross the company distributed three containers of ice and two containers of water in Grand Bahama, and a container with baby furniture, diapers, snacks, drinks and other food items are expected to sail in the coming days, along with three containers of fresh produce. A produce container will each be sent to Grand Bahama, Abaco and New Providence to assist with the evacuees being housed in shelters. More help is expected over the next few weeks as products are being delivered almost daily to AML's freight forwarder in Florida.

"Our thoughts and prayers remain with the persons impacted by Hurricane Dorian", said Gavin Watchorn, President & CEO. "We want to give support and help however we can. Many of our international vendors have committed to sending supplies and products, and as quickly as items are received in our warehouse in the US, we will ship them out so that those persons affected can get the relief they need".

The company has also been working diligently to restock and get fresh product and general merchandise into Grand Bahama to be able to service the community. "Containers of fresh produce, bread and other perishable items have already begun arriving. We recognize that we have a responsibility to meet the needs of Grand Bahamians", Watchorn says.

The company through its Domino's brand has also given support by donating more than 200 pizzas to victims and first responders in both Abaco and Grand Bahama. Both Domino's Freeport and the Deli in Solomon's Lucaya is providing the 275 AML employees in Grand Bahama with daily hot meals. The company has also made it available for customers to make donations at the registers in their Solomon's, Solomon's Fresh Market and Cost Right stores in Nassau, as well as online at www.dominos242.com.
