With The Goal To Raise \$150K For Families in Need***

Nassau, Bahamas, November 18, 2019—Today, officials from AML Foods Limited officially launched the company's 4th Annual *Feed 5000 Families* holiday giveback. Executives also announced that the company will jumpstart their goal of raising \$150,000
